

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-180, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-187, 22-188, 23-03 and 23-09, by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. "Section 4 of Public Law No. 22-180, as amended  
2 by Public Law No. 22-188, is hereby further amended to read  
3 as follows:

4 "Section 4. Of the \$8,820,000 appropriated under this  
5 act, \$2,520,000 shall be apportioned for public projects  
6 and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State.

18 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-180, as amended by  
 19 Public Law No. 22-188, is hereby further amended to read as  
 20 follows:

21 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
 22 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
 23 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
 24 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not limited  
 25 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee

1 shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so  
2 much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the  
3 purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are  
4 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee  
5 of the funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall  
6 be the Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee  
7 of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act  
8 shall be the President of the Federated States of  
9 Micronesia or his designee; EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of  
10 funds appropriated under section 3(1) of this act shall be  
11 the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee  
12 of funds appropriated under section 3(2) of this act shall  
13 be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the  
14 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(b),  
15 4(1)(k), 4(1)(l), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d),  
16 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(n), 4(2)(p), 4(2)(s),  
17 4(2)(t), 4(2)(u), 4(2)(v) and 4(2)(aa) of this act shall be  
18 the Secretary of the Department of Transportation,  
19 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the  
20 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(a),  
21 4(1)(j), 4(2)(f), 4(2)(j), 4(2)(k), 4(2)(l), 4(2)(m),  
22 4(2)(r), 4(2)(x), 4(3)(m) and 4(2)(n) of this act shall be  
23 the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of  
24 funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(i) of this act  
25 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Education or

1 her designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
2 subsection 4(2)(o) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Port  
3 Authority (PPA); the allottee of funds appropriated under  
4 subsections 4(2)(w), 4(2)(q) and 4(2)(z) of this act shall  
5 be the Mayor of Sapwuahfik Municipal Government or his  
6 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under  
7 subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor  
8 of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of the funds  
9 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the  
10 Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee  
11 of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act  
12 shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his  
13 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under  
14 subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas  
15 Development Authority; the allottee of the funds  
16 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the  
17 Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the  
18 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall  
19 lapse on September 30, 2025.”

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1           Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2   President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
3   becoming law without such approval.
