

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140, 19-150, 20-05, 20-15, 20-33, 20-48, 20-63, 20-71, 20-156, 20-175, 21-22, 21-52, 21-146, 21-195, 21-213, 21-244, 22-62 and 22-111, by amending sections 2, 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund priority infrastructure projects and other programs for Yap and Pohnpei States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 19-124, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 19-140 and 20-05 and 21-244, is hereby further
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 2. Of the \$11,300,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$1,750,000 shall be apportioned for priority
6 infrastructure projects in the state of Yap.

21 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by
 22 Public Laws Nos. 19-133, 19-140, 20-05, 20-15, 20-33, 20-48, 20-63,
 23 20-156, 21-22, 21-146, 21-195, 21-244 and 22-111, is hereby further
 24 amended to read as follows:

25 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and

1 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
2 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
3 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
4 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
5 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
6 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
7 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
8 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
9 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
10 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of
11 the State of Yap or his designee. The allottee of the
12 funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act
13 shall be the President of the Federated States of
14 Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee
15 of funds appropriated under subsections 3(1)(a) and
16 3(1)(b) of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae
17 State or his designee, the allottee of funds
18 appropriated under subsections 4(1)(c), 4(1)(d),
19 4(1)(e), 4(1)(g), 4(1)(h), 4(1)(i), 4(1)(j), 4(1)(k),
20 4(1)(l), 4(1)(m), 4(1)(n), 4(1)(o), 4(2)(f), 4(3)(k),
21 4(3)(q), 4(3)(s), 4(3)(af), 4(4)(b), 4(4)(d) and
22 4(4)(f), shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority
23 (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
24 subsections 4(1)(a), 4(1)(b), 4(1)(f), 4(1)(p),
25 4(1)(q), 4(1)(r), 4(1)(s), 4(1)(t), 4(1)(u), 4(1)(v),

1 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i),
2 4(2)(j), 4(3)(x), and 4(3)(o) shall be the Secretary of
3 the Department of Transportation, Communications and
4 Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
5 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(f), 4(3)(i),
6 4(3)(w) and 4(3)(aa) of this act shall be the Luhk en
7 Moanlap of Kitti, the allottee of funds appropriated
8 under subsection 4(3)(ad) of this act shall be the
9 Chief Justice of Madolenihmw or his designee, the
10 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
11 4(3)(ae) of this act shall be the Chief Justice of
12 Kitti or his designee; the allottee of funds
13 appropriated under subsection 4(3)(an) of this act
14 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health and
15 Social Affairs or his designee. The allottee of the
16 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(ak) and
17 4(3)(ao) of this act shall be the Vice President of the
18 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the
19 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
20 4(3)(al) and 4(3)(ap) of this act shall be the
21 Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw Municipal Government
22 or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated
23 under subsections 5(1)(2) and 5(1)(7) of this act shall
24 be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the
25 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)(3)

1 of this act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development
2 Authority (MIDA); the allottee of funds appropriated
3 under subsections 5(1)(1) and 5(1)(4) of this act shall
4 be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his
5 designee; EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds
6 appropriated under subsection 5(1)(m) of this act shall
7 be the FSM Telecommunication Corporation; the allottee
8 of funds appropriated under subsection 5(1)(5) of this
9 act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
10 Authority (SNDA); the allottee of funds appropriated
11 under subsection 5(1)(6) of this act shall be the
12 Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the
13 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act
14 shall lapse on September 30, 2024.”

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1 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
